## GENERAL RULES

1. All specimens exhibited in the Horticultural and Honey Section must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or of his employer and have been produced by either for a period of not less than two months prior to the show. Scrutineers will be appointed to visit gardens or apiary where necessary.
2. The show marquee will open for staging of exhibits on the Wednesday prior to show day from 3.00pm till 8pm and from 7:30 to 9am on the day of the show, after which time all exhibitors must retire from the marquee in readiness for judging at 9:15am. **FLORAL ART EXHIBITS** must be executed in the marquee. **Please use entrance D on the A453 Mold – Denbigh Road.**
3. **Exhibitors must not remove or dispose of their exhibits before 5:30pm on the day of the show. Prize money will be paid at 4:30pm and exhibits must be removed by 7pm.**
4. Exhibits will receive their benching cards in the marquee; these are to be placed (reversed) in front of or on the exhibit. Any exhibit without a card will be considered not for judging. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCPETED.**
5. No unauthorised person shall enter the marquee after judging commences until the marquee is officially opened.
6. The judges have the power to award, withhold or amend prizes; their decision shall be final except where breach of the rules is discovered. Only signed award of the judges will be accepted as evidence that a prize has been won. The production of a prize card will not entitle any exhibitor to a prize. All protests must be delivered to the Show Secretary (in writing) before 2pm on the day of the show together with the sum of £10.
7. No exhibitor shall act as a judge or steward in the section in which she or he exhibits.
8. In line with other shows, we have amalgamated Open and Amateur Classes.
9. Initial entries must be sent to the secretary by the closing date. **Exhibitors making entries to the value of £8.00 or more in any combination of sections will receive one free admission pass to the show.** Entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. No additional entries, substitutions or amendments will be accepted after the entry close date. Fees payable prior to closing date.
10. The committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained and it is only on this understanding that entries will be accepted.
11. Points awarded as follows: - 1<sup>st</sup> Prize – 3 Points; 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize – 2 Points; 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize – 1 Point. An exhibitor can only claim one set of points per class.

All extracted honey shall be graded for colour with grading classes approved by the Beekeepers Association.

| 113g/4oz. Butter/margarine or mixed | 113g/4oz sultanas        |
| 227g/8oz honey                      | 2 tsp spice              |
| 2 large Eggs                        | ½tsp lemon juice         |
| 227g/8oz. self-raising flour        | pinch of salt            |
| 113g/4oz currants                   | Milk to mix if necessary |
| 113g/4oz mixed peel                 | 7" round cake tin        |

### Method

Warm the oven. Cream butter/margarine and honey. Beat eggs well and add them alternatively with the sifted flour but save a little flour to add with the fruit. Beat all together, lightly. A little milk may be added (up to 3 tablespoons) if necessary. Fold in the fruit and stir well. Bake in a well buttered tin for approx. 4 hours (or until just firm to touch) in a moderate oven 160C/325F

360g (12oz.) porridge oats	90g (3oz.) honey
120g (4oz.) plain flour	60g (2oz.) sugar
270g (9oz.) packet of Stork or a firm baking margarine	

### Method

Mix all together, roll out to a ¼ inch thickness on a well-floured board. Cut into rounds. Bake at 160C/325F/ gas mark 3 for 15 20 minutes, till golden brown.

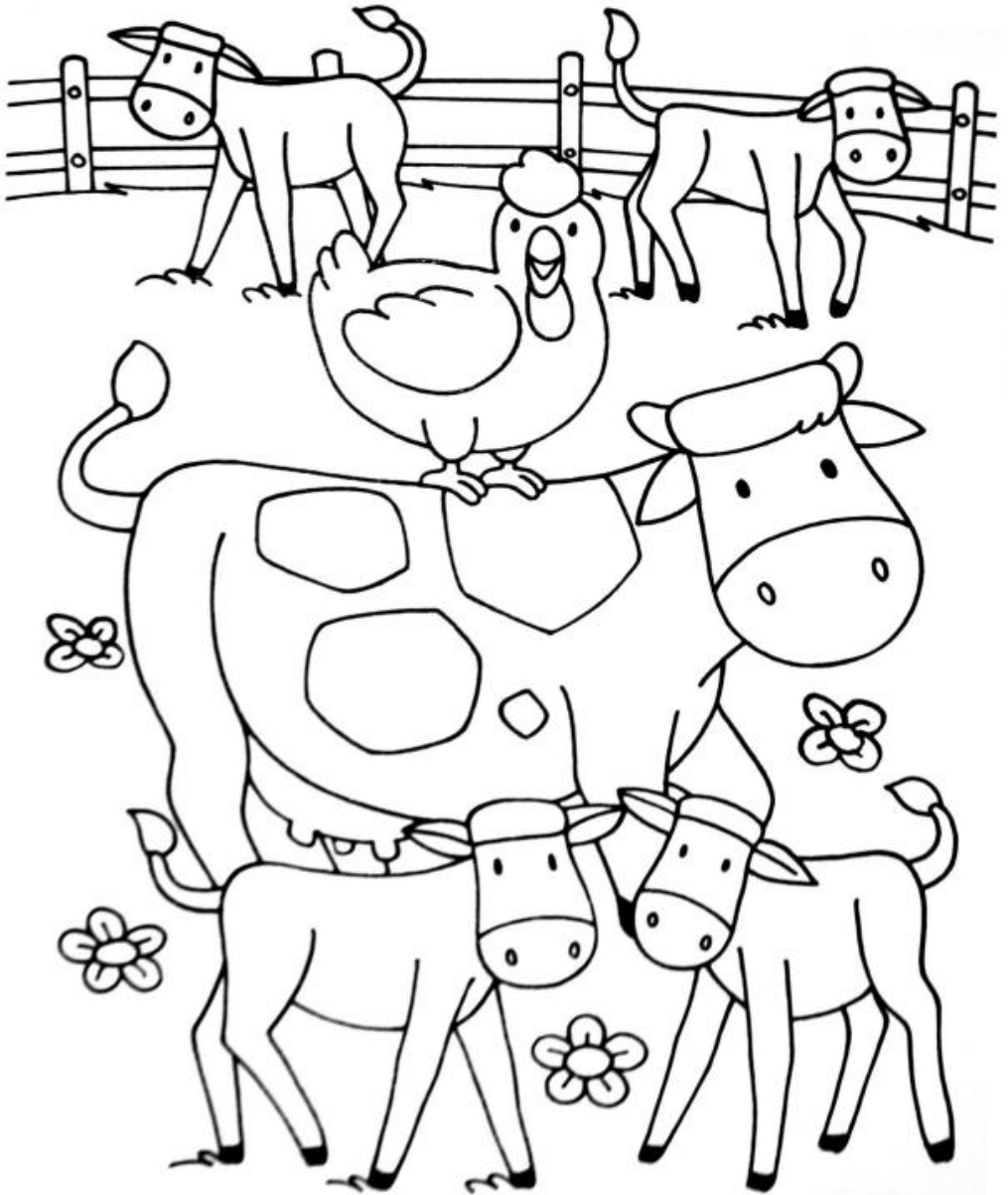
